	03 Aug 2025	I strongly object to the application for a 24-hour licence and the sale of alcohol at this proposed food warehouse across from our homes. This retail park is not an appropriate location for such operations, especially given that it is directly surrounded by residential properties and is within 100 yards of Stukeley Meadows Primary School. Granting a 24-hour alcohol licence in such a location poses serious risks to public safety, encourages anti-social behaviour, and significantly disrupts the peace and security of local residents — including young families and vulnerable individuals. Late-night vehicle activity, noise, potential loitering, and public disturbances are unacceptable in what has always been a quiet, family-friendly neighbourhood. Furthermore, the retail park already suffers from limited parking. Increased traffic from a 24-hour store will only worsen congestion and remove the already scarce parking we residents rely on, especially during evenings and weekends. This application prioritises commercial convenience over the well-being of an entire community. The idea that alcohol could be sold around the clock just steps from a school and people's homes is entirely inappropriate. We urge the council to reject this application in full.
