Warm Hub	£980.00	£980.00 (04/11/2022 - 24/02/2023	Godmanchester Town Council are acutely aware of the cost of living and energy crisis which may affect our community over the winter months. Using the new meeting room facilities at Godmanchester Community Nursery, we plan to deliver a community warm hub. The warm hub will be open weekly and free for the community to access, offering refreshments, activities, and a warm space for people throughout the coldest of the winter months. Funding from the community chest will allow us to initially set up the warm hub, 16 weeks hire for the space will cost £480, £300 to spend on activities, board games, art supplies etc. £100 to spend on advertising, £100 to spend on refreshments such as tea/coffee, soft drinks, and biscuits. This will bring us to a total of £980 to bring the warm hub to fruition. The aspiration is for the hub to become a place where members of the community can be signposted to other organisations, groups or charities offering financial or emotional support.
