Several people have said they would like to have a games club in the village, and this will respond to their needs. We have a volunteer to run a film club in the evenings and this will support that activity too. Having something purposeful to attend in a warm hub will encourage people to come and we think having some events in the evening will enable people to attend and be warm in the evenings. The funding will be used to provide films, games and hot drinks for participants. The total cost for January 2023 to April 2023 should be no more than £500. We do not have any other sources of funding, but we have the support of the Parish Council in delivering this initiative for the village. We undertook a survey recently of villagers and they indicated that they would support this initiative and would welcome the opportunity to meet in the warm with other members of our community. With a population of just 130 in Kings Ripton and approximately 200 in Abbots Ripton it is essential to provide such community events and it's an important way for us to keep an eye on vulnerable residents and support them through the winter.</li> <li>The funding will be used to train two new volunteers to support people who are struggling with grief. Since the start of the pandemic, Cruse has seen a 52% increase in the demand for services and this is expected to continue. Without new volunteers our waiting lists will increase, and more people will suffer from inexplicable sadness, fear, self-harm, isolation and misuse of alcohol. Offering immediate support means no one is left unsupported in grief. The total cost of the project is £1116.00.
