The Community Hub, Little Paxton CIC	£1,000	£6,290	The money will be used to purchase and install acoustic panels in the Community Hub, Little Paxton. £6290 (incl VAT). Main Hall £5370 and meeting rooms £920. The charity has set aside reserves and applied for another grant to achieve full funding. Four quotes ranging between £6290 and £12000 have been obtained and, as all will have the same effect, the cheapest, is preferred. The project has 2 distinct elements, the main hall and meeting rooms so if full funding is not achieved the project can be descoped to deliver part of the improvements.
