We wish to apply for the maximum of 1,000.00p, to contribute towards our weekly costs Staff: Volunteers from the church group are nil cost but the purchase/prep/clearing of the meals takes about 1 hour per day @ 12.00p and 5.00per meal for attendees. Additional heating is required on Warm Space days @ 5.00/day. Meals/hot drinks/snacks: 5.00/attendee Labour: 12.00/day (currently 1 per week with numbers growing) Additional heating: 5.00/day The Warm Space is currently being funded by my company and will continue to do so if it is required. We started in January to assess the uptake. It was slow at first but now we get attendances of 10-12 and expect this to rise in the coming weeks. Our Warm Space is in a way duplicated by the Parish Council Warm Hub. This idea has been developed with involvement of the vicar/GP practice/us.
