Executive Summary:

Following the publishing of the Cabinet report for this Community Infrastructure Round the following items have been noted and are clarified and corrected below:

- Paragraph 2.8 Should be ‘in order FOR the Implementation’
- Proposal 4.2 (f) Should read ‘the Healthy Open Space Strategy, Indoor and Built Sports Facility Strategy and the Playing Pitch and Outdoor Sports Strategy.’
- Proposal 4.3 Total Project Cost should be £600,000.00 with a CIL ask of £300,000.00. The indicative score here is 39 not 40 as per 4.3 (d)
- Proposal 4.3 (f) Planning permission was granted in February 2026, so this subjective can be removed.
- Proposal 4.6 (a) Councillor Lowe, Ward Councillor for Warboys, wrote a letter of support for the project.
- Proposal 4.6 (b) When English Lit is referred to this is English Literature.
- Proposal 4.9 The indicative score is 31 (25 + 6) as per the bottom of section 4.9 (e)
