Decision Name	A14 Huntingdon To Cambridge - Proposed 60mph speed limit
Date of Decision	19 May 2005

Describe the Decision taken	<p>The Cabinet supported a proposal by the Highways Agency to introduce a 60mph speed limit on the A14 between Huntingdon and Cambridge for a trial period. However, the Cabinet indicated their preference in the long term for variable speed limits together with SPECs cameras on this section of the A14 which should be strategically placed in the vicinity of the junctions.</p>
What were the reasons for taking the Decision?	<p>To help ease continued problems on the A14 and minimise accidents and congestion prior to the proposed upgrade.</p>
