Describe the Decision taken	Recorded their concern that the paper did not address operational issues associated with the scope of the areas to be cleaned and the delivery of the service. Commented that an additional cleansing service on a Sunday was likely to cause some early morning noise which could be seen as being detrimental to some residents. Requested the Overview and Scrutiny Panel to investigate further the introduction of Sunday cleansing services in light of the Cabinet's views and to prepare a proposal for consideration as part of the Council's Medium Term Plan in due course; Agreed that financial contributions towards the cost of implementing additional cleansing be sought from the various Town Councils and that the use of Alcohol Disorder Zones be investigated.
