Describe the Decision taken	Agreed to use the 2008/09 grant of £162,400 in the current year for decent homes for vulnerable people – to rectify Category 1 hazards, and to provide thermal efficiency improvements; and that prior year grants be rephased as set out in paragraph 4.6 of the report now submitted for the same purposes; requested the review of the programme for future years once the basis and likelihood of the allocation of grant in future years is known and agreed that £75,000 of the previous year's grant be used in the current year to fund the Sustainable Homes Retro-Fit Scheme.
