**Describe the Decision taken** Noted progress made towards the implementation of the Council's Carbon Management Plan and the positive impact this has had on energy use and bills at the Council's main sites; supported the undertaking of cross functional energy reviews as a way of maximising cost savings and the continued use of the Salix ring-fenced funding and Environment Strategy Capital Funding to implement further energy saving projects and authorised the Managing Directors, after consultation with Executive Councillors, to approve the installation of Solar PV on the Council's main sites and if necessary report back to the next meeting.
