Agrees that the Parking Service should engage with the County Council about the development comprehensive traffic management strategy Huntingdonshire that includes funding by the County for the infrastructure costs if the strategy proposes a Civil Enforcement Area for the district.

The Consultant's report did not reach a definitive conclusion on whether the Council should support the County Council in adopting Civil Parking Enforcement powers and to act as the County Council's agent in the delivery of the powers. Therefore the report is necessary to determine the position of the Council and then to work with the County Council on the development future traffic of management plans for Huntingdonshire
