Describe the Decision taken	The Cabinet has evaluated the options based on patient benefits, cost, risk and impact and endorsed the Pharmacy Model (free to patient) with Charged Household Collections as the option to provide a sharps clinical waste and disposal service in the District.
What were the reasons for taking the Decision?	The report sets out the options and costs left to HDC to manage its responsibilities under the Controlled Waste (England and Wales) Regulations 2012 (CWR) and the Environmental Protection Act 1990 (EPA) whereby Waste Collection Authorities were made responsible for ensuring collections of clinical waste from householders and self-treating patients on request.
