<b>Describe the Decision taken</b>	<p>The Cabinet supported the introduction of a new process for the allocation of Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) funding including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ The introduction of a new application form and guidance (as outlined in Appendices 2 &amp; 3 of the report now submitted)</li><li>▪ Delegating authority to the Corporate Director (Place) and the Service Manager (Growth) in consultation with the Leader and Executive Councillor for Strategic Planning for the allocation of CIL funding for smaller funding applications in the Local Bids category (£50,000 or less) including those from non-parished areas. Those decisions will be notified to Cabinet twice yearly.</li><li>▪ Approving the process requiring applications requesting more than £50,000 in the Strategic Bids category to be approved by Cabinet.</li></ul>
