We found the following facts:

That the application was for a variation of an existing licence.

The application was to permit the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises for hours that are shorter than the existing permission for the sale for consumption off the premises.

The Application for recorded music as this premises benefits from the exemptions provided by the Live Music Act.

The representation received that was outside the statutory consultation period.

Our decision is as follows:

That the application be granted as applied for.

Our reasons for reaching the decision are as follows:

The Sub-Committee were satisfied that granting the licence would not breach any of the four licensing objectives.

The conditions already attached to the licence will continue to apply.
