18. MINUTES

The Minutes of the meeting of the Cabinet held on 15th May 2003 were approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

19. CAMBRIDGESHIRE & PETERBOROUGH STRUCTURE PLAN RESPONSES TO THE EXAMINATION IN PUBLIC PANEL RECOMMENDATIONS AND PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO THE STRUCTURE PLAN

Further to Minute No. 01/196 and by way of a report by the Head of Planning Services (a copy of which is appended in the Minute Book) Members were acquainted with modifications to the draft Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Structure Plan following the public examination held during the period 29th October and 4th December 2002.

The Cabinet were pleased to note that the Panel had supported the District Council's representations in relation to the balance of housing provision for the District and the needs of rural areas in terms of economic and social regeneration. However, the Panel had rejected the Council's recommendation that RAF Alconbury should be removed from the list of strategic employment sites in the area (Policy P2/3 refers). Having reiterated the need to address the provision of infrastructure as part of any proposed development, the Cabinet
