10. REVIEW OF PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCIES IN CAMBRIDGESHIRE AND PETERBOROUGH

The Panel were advised that the Boundary Commission had received objections to the proposals and were informed that they would be holding a public inquiry into the proposals for parliamentary constituency boundaries in Cambridgeshire and Peterborough on 24th February 2004 at The Guildhall, Cambridge.
