

COMMENTS FROM OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY PANEL (PERFORMANCE AND GROWTH)

REVIEW OF PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCY BOUNDARIES

- 5.2 The Panel discussed the Review of Parliamentary Constituency Boundaries at its meeting on 7th July 2021.
- 5.3 Concern was expressed that the proposals would split the District between three parliamentary constituencies. The creation of a new proposed constituency of St Neots caused further concern due to the geographical boundaries of the proposal, specifically the inclusion of the District Ward of Fenstanton and St Neots Wards with specific wards within South Cambridgeshire district. It was felt that Huntingdonshire residents located within these wards of this proposed constituency would have no affinity with the other residents located across the District boundary.
