SMALL SCALE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENTS (Report by Head of Environment & Transport)

1. PURPOSE

1.1 This paper reports on the small scale environmental improvement schemes to be completed by March 2005, and proposes a programme of schemes for 2005/06.

2. SELECTION OF SCHEMES

- 2.1 A budget of £82k is approved in 2005/06 for "Small Scale Environmental Improvements". To qualify for funding from this budget a scheme must also attract a minimum of 25% funding from an outside source, such as Parish or Town Council, or Landfill Tax Credit.
- 2.2 Cabinet agreed the criteria for the prioritisation of the schemes in 2002/03 and this has been applied to the selection of schemes for 2005/06.
- 2.3 Town and Parish Councils were asked in October to submit schemes for consideration in this year's programme.

3. 2004/05 SCHEMES

3.1 The schemes approved in the 2004/5 programme were as follows:

Location

- 1) Ramsey New railings
- 2) Earith Pond Repairs
- 3) Hilton Village Hall Lighting
- 4) Ramsey Barge Dock Improvements
- 5) Wistow Church Wall Restoration
- 6) Huntingdon Medway Centre footpath alterations

Position

In manufacture Order placed Complete Postponed Order placed In design

The Ramsey Barge Dock did not proceed due to on-going land ownership issues and a previous assessed scheme - Huntingdon Medway Centre was added.

4. FUTURE SCHEMES

4.1 Following submissions from Town and Parish Councils schemes have been assessed (Annex 1) and the highest scoring schemes up to the

approved budget (based on preliminary estimates) for 2005/06 are listed below:-

4.2 Ramsey Barge Dock is still a possibility for construction and of high priority but is dependent on the development plans for the northern area. It is proposed that this scheme is scheduled for 2006/07 when the legal matters are resolved. If this is completed early, funding for the scheme will be considered at that time.

5. CONCLUSIONS

- 5.1 The small scale environmental improvement funding has enabled minor improvements to be carried out in many villages and locations.
- 5.2 There is great interest from town and parish councils in promoting future schemes and the appraisal process has now been shown to work satisfactorily.
- 5.3 Approval is sought for those schemes with shown in paragraph 4.1 above. In the event that these cannot proceed for any reason during 2005/06 the next schemes in the order of priority will be carried out or Ramsey Barge Dock will be brought forward.
 Annex 2 identifies the budget allocated for these schemes and is the Release of Funds form.

6. **RECOMMENDATION**

- 6.1 It is recommended that the Cabinet:
 - i) note the schemes committed/completed to date
 - ii) approve, for completion during 2005/06, the schemes at paragraph 4.1 above and the release of funds from the MTP to facilitate this.

Justification
