

Backwoodsman Limited
Events Licence Application(s) x 3
Explanatory Note to Accompany Application(s)

Backwoodsman Limited, the longstanding Premises Licence Holder at Abbots Ripton Hall (“ARH”) are today making three (3) applications for new Premises Licences at ARH.

The applications can be summarised as follows:

1. Small events to 11pm
2. Small events after 11pm
3. Medium events

Small events to 11pm will have a maximum capacity of 4999 persons with all Licensable Activities ending by or at 11pm.

Small events after 11pm will also have a maximum capacity of 4999 persons but Licensable Activities could effectively be provided 24/7 from Thursday to Monday morning. This follows the template of another Premises Licence Held by the applicant.

Medium events are for capacities over 5000 but no more than 14,999 persons. The Licensable Activities for these events can also be provided 24/7 from Thursday to Monday following the template noted above, but these events are subject to more stringent conditions.

For each application a schedule of suggested conditions has been prepared to promote the four Licensing Objectives. These conditions should be well known to the Responsible Authorities and Other Persons because they derive from existing authorisations for ARH, and which have been shown to promote the Licensing Objectives.

Pre-application dialogue has been undertaken with the Licensing Authority regarding these applications, but the applicant is happy to engage with any person or persons concerned by these applications to explain them in more detail.

The area to be covered by these Premises Licences is significant, but this does not mean that the events to be held will utilise the entire licensed area. Rather, event specific site plans will be drawn up depending on the size and proposed location of each event.
